PROSPECTUS

Mercy College of Nursing is a member of Association of the Managements of Self Financing Nursing Colleges of Kerala (AMSFNCK). The admission is done by the AMSFNCK based on merit.

Criteria Of Eligibility For Admission

Nationality : Candidates must be Citizen of India/ Children or dependents of Non Resident Indians.

Academic : i) As per Indian Indian Nursing Council norms, the candidates should have passed +2 class with 50% aggregate in Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English.

ii) Kerala University of Health Science norms for Admission for B.Sc.Nursing is as under :

Admission Requirements

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission(As per University Norms)
2. The minimum educational requirements shall be passing of :
Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination(12 years course), Or Senior School Certificate Examination (10+2), Pre-Degree Examination (10+2), or an equivalent with 12 years schooling from a recognized board or university with Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology)and English with minimum of aggregate marks(as per INC norms)
3. Candidate shall be medically fit.

Duration

- i) Duration of the programme shall be four years.
- ii) Internship Integrated practice is incorporated with respective practical hours in each year.
- iii) Rounding off of the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is not permitted.
- iv) Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalence of the qualifying examination from any University in Kerala.
- v) The norms of eligibility prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council / Kerala Nurses & Midwives Council/ Affiliating University also apply.

Relaxation in marks

For all courses, candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (as per G.O.(P) No. 208/66//Edn dated 2.5.1996,G.O.(MS) No.95/08/SCSTDD dated 06/10/2008 and amendments thereof, with a total annual family income not exceeding Rs.4.5 lakhs, will have a relaxation of 5% marks in the qualifying examination. They need only 45% in the case of Mathematics/Biology/Biotechnology/Computer Science and 45% marks in the case of optional subjects put together. The Scheduled Tribes candidates need only a pass in the qualifying examination.

Age

Applicants should complete 17 years of age on 31st December 2013. No relaxation of age will be allowed.

Applications submitted should be complete in all respects. The candidate should fill in all the items in the Application Form in his/her own handwriting.

Copies of Certificates/ Documents attested by a Gazetted Officer or Head of the Institution last studied to be submitted along with the application:

- a. 10th/12th certificate in proof of date of birth.
- b. Mark list of qualifying examination.
- c. Certificate of good conduct from the institution last attended issue within six months.
- d. Certificate in proof of SEBC/OBC/SC/ST status obtained from Tahasildar concerned.
- e. Application not accompanied by documents in proof of claims made therein will be summarily rejected without further intimation. Documents / Certificates furnished after submission of the application will not be entertained under any circumstances. No opportunity will be given to incorporate any details or document after the submission of the application .Late and incomplete application will be rejected.
- f. Candidates are instructed not to enclose any original certificates along with the application.

Original Certificates

All original certificates are to be produced at the time of admission. Besides the following certificates have to be produced in original.

1. Equivalence / recognition certificate of the qualifying examination.
2. Conduct certificate
3. Migration Certificate
4. Transfer certificate
5. Certificate from Head of Institution last studied
6. Passport size photograph(10 nos)

Additionally, two sets of photocopies of all the certificates/documents attested by Gazatted officers/Principal of the Institution last attended have to be submitted at the time of admission.
